AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES OF THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 452 of the acts of 1969 is hereby
2 amended in item 0511-0000 by striking out, in line 1, the
3 word "ninety-five" and inserting in place thereof the word:
4 —ninety-six, and by inserting after the word "positions", in
5 line 2, the following words:—provided that the incumbent
6 of the position on requisition A88738 shall be deemed to be
7 permanently appointed thereto under chapter thirty-one of
8 the General Laws, subject to passing a qualifying examina-
9 tion.
