AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION TO IMPOSE FINES IN LIEU OF SUSPENSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding the following paragraph to section 23: — In lieu of any
3 suspension that may be imposed under this chapter, the Com-
4 mission may impose a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars
5 for any one offense.
