**AN ACT REPEALING SO-CALLED FAIR TRADE LAWS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Sections fourteen A through fourteen D inclusive of chapter 2 ninety-three of the General Laws are hereby repealed.

For Amendment of the Constitution

That the Constitution of the United States

be amended in the following manner:

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People in each State, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
