## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT LIMITING THE OBLIGATION OF SCHOOL COMMITTEES TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FOR STUDENTS TO SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN SCHOOLS OTHER THAN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 46B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 12 of chapter 546 of the acts of  
3 1969, is hereby further amended by inserting after the first  
4 sentence the following sentence: — However the board of  
5 education in cooperation with such other departments and  
6 agencies as it deems advisable may issue regulations limiting the  
7 obligation to provide transportation in situations where a  
8 school committee is offering equivalent programs for the handi-  
9 capped in the public schools.

Section 100 of chapter 11 of the Statutes of the State
