AN ACT PROVIDING THAT JUSTICES OF THE PEACE MAY SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGES ANY PLACE WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

- Section 39 of chapter 207 of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended by section 3 of chapter 81 of the acts of 1968,
- 3 is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and
- 4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: The governor
- 5 may in his discretion designate a justice of the peace in each
- 6 town and such further number, not exceeding one for every five
- 7 thousand inhabitants of a city or town, as he considers
- 8 expedient, to solemnize marriages anywhere within the common-
- 9 wealth, and may for cause at any time revoke such designation.
