

Chap.358 AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMISSIONER OF CONSERVATION TO LEASE CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF SPENCER TO THE WORCESTER COUNTY 4 H CAMP COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The commissioner of conservation, with the approval of the governor and council, is hereby authorized and directed to lease, for a term not exceeding twenty-five years, to the Worcester County 4 H Camp Committee, appointed by the county commissioners of the county of Worcester, a certain tract of land, now part of a state forest and consisting of approximately twelve acres on the shores of Thompson's pond in the town of Spencer, together with the buildings thereon, to be used as a meeting place for said Worcester County 4 H Camp Committee and for the development of interest in agriculture by young people. Said lease shall contain such terms and conditions as will comply with all laws in relation to the protection of fish, birds and quadrupeds and the preservation and development of said forest. Notwithstanding said lease the control and supervision of the land so leased shall remain under said commissioner, and all provisions of law relating to state forests not inconsistent with this act shall remain in full force and effect. Upon failure of said Worcester County 4 H Camp Committee, for a period of two years, to make use of said property for the purpose of said lease, said commissioner may immediately cancel said lease upon written notification to said committee. Upon termination of said lease any building or other structure on the leased property shall become the property of the commonwealth. Except as above provided, nothing in this act shall be construed to prevent the use of said forest by the public to the same extent as if this act had not been passed.

Chap.359 AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF MEDICAL SERVICE CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

G. L. (Ter. Ed.), 176B, § 3, etc., amended.

Powers of medical service corporations.

Section 3 of chapter 176B of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 306 of the acts of 1941, is hereby amended by adding at the end the following paragraph: —

Any medical service corporation may contract with a corporation formed under chapter one hundred and seventy-six A for the joint or co-operative administration of their affairs.

Chap.360 AN ACT PERMITTING AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT WHICH MAY BE EXPENDED BY THE STATE BOARD FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURNISHING AID DURING REHABILITATION TO CERTAIN PERSONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:
