AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONSTRUCT A SWIMMING POOL AT GREENLEAF PARK IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of natural resources is hereby authorized
