AN ACT PERMITTING ANY TEACHER WHO IS A MEMBER OF A RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO ESTABLISH PREVIOUS SERVICE AS A TEACHER IN NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS AS CREDITABLE SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General
- 2 laws is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (m) the
- 3 following paragraph: —
- 4 (n) Any member of a retirement system who is engaged
- 5 in a teaching position and who previously served as a teacher
- 6 in any non-public school may establish such service, not in
- 7 excess of ten years, as creditable service by depositing in the
- 8 annuity savings fund of the system which he is a member an
- 9 amount equal to five per cent of his annual rate of compensa-
- 10 tion when he became a member of such a retirement system
- 11 multiplied by the number of years or fraction thereof for which
- 12 he is entitled to such creditable service, providing that said
- 13 member holds a certificate issued by the Department of Edu-
- 14 cation.
