AN ACT REQUIRING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO PAY FOR THE LOSS IN VALUE TO PROPERTY OCCASIONED BY THE NOISE OF AIRCRAFT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 465 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 3 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 3A.* The authority shall be required to pay those
- 4 persons who reside in close proximity to the Logan airport the
- 5 amount of money which represents the loss in value to the real
- 6 estate owned by such persons occasioned by the noise from
- 7 aircraft using such aircraft.
