AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO ENLARGE THE UNDERPASS AT THE MELROSE STREET CROSSING IN THE CITY OF MELROSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the depart-  
2 ment of public utilities is hereby authorized and directed to  
3 order the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority to en-  
4 large the underpass at the Melrose street crossing in the city of  
5 Melrose to a minimum width of forty feet, and to include five  
6 food sidewalks with guardrails installed for the protection of  
7 school children. The charges and expenses of making such  
8 alteration shall be determined in accordance with sections  
9 sixty-one through sixty-three of chapter one hundred and fifty-  
10 nine of the General Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same in reference:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the depart-  
2 ment of public utilities is hereby authorized and directed to  
3 enlarge the sidewalk at the Melrose Street crossing in the city of  
4 Melrose to a minimum width of forty feet, and to include five  
5 feet sidewalk with gutters installed for the protection of  
6 school children. The charges and expenses of making such  
7 alterations shall be determined in accordance with section  
8 forty-one through sixty-three of chapter one hundred and fifty-  
9 one of the General Laws.
