AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A BAND CONCERT SHELL IN THE CITY OF MELROSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
