

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 577

By Mr. McBride of Adams, petition of Anthony P. McBride that the Department of Natural Resources be directed to convey certain land to the town of Adams for park and recreation purposes. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND TO THE TOWN OF ADAMS FOR PARK AND RECREATION PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commonwealth, acting through its department of natural  
2 resources, is hereby directed to convey to the town of Adams,  
3 for park and recreation purposes, by a deed approved as to  
4 form by the attorney general, all of its right, title and interest  
5 of whatever nature, kind or description in a certain parcel of  
6 land located in the Mount Greylock State Reservation in said  
7 town and bounded and described as follows: —

8 Beginning at the stone monument marking the southwest  
9 corner of the Town of Adams,

10 Thence North 3° 50' East in the line between the Towns of  
11 Adams and New Ashford 11,031 feet to the stone monument  
12 marking the northeast corner of said Town of New Ashford  
13 and the most southeast corner of the Town of Williamstown;

14 Thence North 2° 24' East in the line between the Towns of  
15 Adams and Williamstown about 1800 feet to the Rockwell  
16 Road, so-called;

17 Thence Northeasterly, Northerly and Northwesterly along  
18 said Rockwell Road about 3150 feet to a point which lies 50

19 feet Southeasterly from the junction of said Rockwell Road  
20 and the Appalachian Trail;

21 Thence Northeasterly, parallel to the said Appalachian Trail,  
22 and 50 feet Southeasterly therefrom, about 1800 feet to a  
23 point lying 100 feet Northerly of the Thunderbolt, so-called,  
24 Ski Trail;

25 Thence Northeasterly, Easterly and Southeasterly, parallel to  
26 said Thunderbolt Trail, and 100 feet Northerly and North-  
27 easterly therefrom, about 2700 feet to a Southerly boundary  
28 of the said Mount Greylock State Reservation (note: the last  
29 400± feet of this course follows the original location of said  
30 Thunderbolt Trail);

31 Thence Westerly in said Reservation boundary about 300  
32 feet to a stone monument;

33 Thence South 30° 01' West in an Easterly boundary of said  
34 Reservation 14,247.5 feet to a stone monument marking a  
35 Southeast corner of said Reservation in the line between the  
36 Town of Adams and Cheshire;

37 Thence North 86° 45' West in said Adams-Cheshire line and  
38 the Southerly boundary of the Reservation 3633.4 feet to the  
39 place of beginning. Containing about 1130 acres of land.

40 In the event that the town of Adams, at any time, ceases to  
41 use the land hereby authorized to be conveyed for park and  
42 recreation purposes, title to said land shall revert to the com-  
43 monwealth.
