AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL JUSTICE AND AN ADDITIONAL SPECIAL JUSTICE IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF BROCKTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 6 of chapter 218
2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 703 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
5 following sentence: — Each district court, other than the muni-
6 cipal court of the city of Boston, shall have one justice, except
7 that the district court of Brockton, the district court of Spring-
8 field, the municipal court of the Dorchester district, the muni-
9 cipal court of the Roxbury district and the first district court
10 of eastern Middlesex shall have two justices each, and the third
11 district court of eastern Middlesex and the central district court
12 of Worcester shall have three justices each.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
