AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR TAX ADJUSTMENT FOR TAX SHELTERED ANNUITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5, subsection 2(a)(1) IV of chapter 555 of the acts 2 of 1971 is hereby stricken.
