The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE ENTIRE NET COST OF THE SERVICE OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY SHALL BE PAID BY THE COMMONWEALTH WITHOUT ASSESSMENT UPON ANY CITY OR TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sections 8, 9, 10, and 11 of chapter 161A of
2 the General Laws are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section 12 of said chapter 161A, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by striking out, in the first sentence,
3 the words “, whether from express service or local service, and
4 all other facts required by the treasurer in order to proceed in
5 accordance with the provisions of this chapter to assess such
6 net cost”, by striking out, in the second paragraph, the second
7 sentence, and by striking out the fourth and fifth paragraphs.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on January first,
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
