By Mr. Kitterman of Pittsfield, petition of William Kitterman that a person or persons having a net annual income of not more than five thousand dollars be eligible for continued occupancy in housing projects for the elderly. Urban Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A PERSON OR PERSONS HAVING AN ANNUAL INCOME OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR CONTINUED OCCUPANCY OF HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 40 of chapter 121B of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following clause: —
- 3 (g) A person or persons having a net annual income of not
- 4 more than five thousand dollars shall be eligible for continued
- 5 occupancy.
