AN ACT TO INCREASE UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The second sentence of subsection (a) of sec-
2 tion 29 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 chapter 1083 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by
4 striking out the words "fifty-five" and inserting in place there-
5 of the words: — "sixty-six and two-thirds."

1 SECTION 2. The fifth sentence of said subsection (a) of
2 section 29 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as amended
3 by section 2 of chapter 1083 of the acts of 1970, is hereby
4 further amended by striking out the words "fifty-five" and
5 inserting in place thereof the words: — "sixty-six and two-
6 thirds."

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on January 1, 1973.
