AN ACT AUTHORIZING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING OPERATED BY THE COMMONWEALTH TO ADVANCE CERTAIN NONPROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES TWO STEPS IN THE SALARY SCHEDULE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following para-
3 graph:—

4 Notwithstanding any provisions of this section to the
5 contrary, any institution of higher education operated by the
6 commonwealth is hereby authorized to advance any nonpro-
7 fessional employee two steps in the salary schedule instead of
8 one if such institution is of the opinion that such employee
9 has rendered outstanding service to the institution.
