AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ACQUIRE SUFFICIENT LAND FROM THE BOSTON PARK DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF STRAIGHTENING OUT THE JAMAICAWAY BETWEEN HUNTINGTON AVENUE OVERPASS AND MORAIN STREET.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to acquire sufficient land from the  
3 Boston park department, or other city officials of the city of  
4 Boston that will enable the metropolitan district commission to  
5 straighten out the Jamaica way between the Huntington avenue  
6 overpass and Moraine street.

1 SECTION 2. For such purpose said commission may expend  
2 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
