### **AN ACT TO ALLOW RECOVERY FOR DAMAGES FOR PAIN AND SUFFERING IN CERTAIN INJURY CASES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

Section 6D of chapter 231 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after the words "(5) consists of a fracture" the following: —

- 1 (6) consists of brain injury
- 2 (7) consists of tendon injury
- 3 (8) consists of cartilage injury
- 4 (9) consists of spinal disc injury
- 5 (10) consists of nerve injury

OF THE GENERAL LAWS RELATIVE TO THE

It is enacted, by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the State,  
that

Section six of chapter 231 of the General Laws is hereby  
amended by adding after the words "(3) consists of a fracture,"  
the following:

- 1 (6) consists of brain injury
- 2 (7) consists of tendon injury
