## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR TAX ADJUSTMENT FOR TAX SHELTERED ANNUITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 4. (d) (2) chapter 555 of the acts of 1971 is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph the
- 3 following phrase:—
- 4 (and furthermore any contributions for annuity contracts
- 5 excluded under section 403 (b of the Code)).

By the Honorable Member for the District of Columbia, in relation to the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States, to provide for the election of the President and Vice President by the people of the several States.

The Constitution of the United States

Article II, Section 1, Clause 2

IN SENATE, FEBRUARY 2, 1867.

ARTICLE II

Section 1. The executive Power shall be vested in a President of the United States, who shall hold his Office for a Term of Years, which shall be determined by Law.

Section 2. (1) The President shall have the Honor and the Power of Pardoning all Offenses, except in Cases of Impeachment. (2) He shall have the Power to grant Reprieves and Fines, and to suspend the Execution of the Law, until he shall have consulted the Judges of the Supreme Court, in all Cases of Impeachment.

Section 3. The President shall be elected in the following Manner: (1) The Electors in each State shall have the Power to choose Electors in such Manner as the Legislature thereof may direct. (2) The Electors shall meet in Person in each State, and shall vote by Ballot.
