Sacco, Jr., for an investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) relative to the advisability of the return to the city of Medford of certain lands in said city held by the Commonwealth under the control of the Metropolitan District Commission. RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY AND FEASIBILITY OF THE RETURN TO THE CITY OF MEDFORD OF CERTAIN LANDS IN SAID CITY HELD BY THE COMMONWEALTH UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
3 tatives, the commissioner of the metropolitan district commis-
4 sion or his designee, the commissioner of public works or his
5 designee, the planning director of the city of Medford, the city
6 engineer of the city of Medford, the chairman of the board of
7 appeals of Medford or his designee, the director of the depart-
8 ment of public works of Medford, and three persons to be
9 appointed by the governor, all of whom shall be selected by
10 the governor from a list which shall be submitted to him by
11 the city manager of the city of Medford, is hereby established
12 for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative
13 to the advisability and feasibility of the return by the common-
14 wealth to the city of Medford of land in said city presently
15 under the control of the metropolitan district commission and
16 the department of public works. Said commission shall consider
17 the beneficial impact of such a return upon Medford's tax base;
18 the possibility of future industrial development of such lands
19 and the improvement of such lands as recreational facilities.
