*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The underpass shall be known as the "North Brighton
- 2 Veterans Underpass". The metropolitan district commission is
- 3 authorized and directed to erect a suitable marker so desig-
- 4 nating this underpass, and to expend such sum as may be
- 5 appropriated therefor.
