AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE LOWELL DISTRICT COURT TO DESIGNATE ONE OF HIS ASSISTANT CLERKS AS ASSISTANT CLERK IN CHARGE OF SIX MAN JURY SESSIONS.
