AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CHRISTIAN A. HERTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS ACT OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The twentieth paragraph of section 1D of chapter 15 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fourth
3 sentence inserted by chapter 1053 of the acts of 1971 and
4 inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 The board is authorized to guarantee the payment of such
6 full or partial scholarships, annually to students in the tenth or
7 eleventh grades by persons or agencies of the board's designa-
8 tion under such regulations as the board shall deem necessary.
