

HOUSE No. 1321

By Mr. Ahearn of Norwood, petition of John R. Buckley and other members of the House that public service corporations be prohibited from expending funds for the purpose of defeating legislation establishing power projects outside the Commonwealth. Government Regulations.

AN ACT PROHIBITING PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATIONS FROM EXPENDING MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFEATING LEGISLATION WHICH WOULD ESTABLISH POWER PROJECTS OUTSIDE THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 155 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 4 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 4A.* No public service corporation doing business
- 4 exclusively in the commonwealth shall expend any funds for
- 5 the purpose of defeating legislation which would establish
- 6 power projects outside the commonwealth.
