**AN ACT PROHIBITING ELECTRIC COMPANIES FROM CHARGING DEMAND USAGE ON METER SERVICE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 94F the following section: —
- 3 *Section 94G.* No electric company shall collect from a cus-
- 4 tomer a charge for electricity in excess of the actual amount
- 5 used.
