AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RATING LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 113B of chapter 175 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of
3 chapter 643 of the acts of 1968, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting after the first sentence the following sentence: — Said
5 classifications and premium charges shall not be determined on
6 the basis of age.
