AN ACT TO PROMOTE EQUALITY OF THE SEXES IN SPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 11 of chapter 131 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking the second sen-
3 tence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
4 The fee for such license shall be as follows: — a sporting
5 license, eight dollars and twenty-five cents; a hunting license,
6 five dollars and twenty-five cents; a fishing license, five dollars
7 and twenty-five cents, except that for such license issued to a
8 minor fifteen to seventeen years of age inclusive, the fee shall
9 be three dollars and twenty-five cents; a trapping license, eight
10 dollars and twenty-five cents, except that for such license
11 issued to a minor fifteen to seventeen years of age inclusive,
12 the fee shall be three dollars and twenty-five cents.
