### AN ACT PERTAINING TO OVERTIME PAY FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 17C and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following new section: —

4 *Section 17C.* If a regular police officer of a city or town  
5 which has not accepted section seventeen F post shall be  
6 required on duty for in excess of eight hours in a tour of duty  
7 or forty hours in a week, he may be given time off equal to  
8 such period of overtime duty or, if time off cannot be given by  
9 reason of a personnel shortage or other cause, he shall be paid  
10 for such period of overtime duty at such an hourly rate as may  
11 be determined by the authority in charge of the police depart-  
12 ment, which rate shall in no event be less than one and one  
13 half times the hourly rate of his regular compensation for his  
14 average weekly hours of regular duty.
