### AN ACT REGULATING THE PAYMENT OF PENSIONS TO RETIRED CITY AND STATE EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision 1 of section 13 of chapter 32 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended in paragraph B striking out in lines 4  
3 and 5, the words "shall be due and payable for the month on  
4 the last day of each month" and inserting in place thereof the  
5 words: - shall be due and payable on the fifteenth and on the  
6 last day of each month.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two

THE SEVENTH ARTICLE OF THE CONSTITUTION IS REVISED  
AND THE SEVEN SEVENTH ARTICLE

AS AMENDED BY THE SEVEN AND SEVENTH LEGISLATURES  
AND THE SEVENTH AND EIGHTH LEGISLATURES

SECTION 1. of section 12 of article 12 of the constitution  
shall be amended in paragraph 2 by striking out the words  
"and 5 the words 'shall be done and passed by the majority  
of the two houses of each month' and inserting in lieu thereof the  
words 'shall be done and passed by the majority of each house  
of each month'.
