By Mr. Carney of Boston, petition of Daniel W. Carney for legislation to require motor vehicle physical damage insurance policies covering damage resulting from collisions to permit repairs to be made by repairmen chosen by the insured. Insurance.

AN ACT TO REQUIRE MOTOR VEHICLE PHYSICAL DAMAGE INSURANCE POLICIES COVERING DAMAGE RESULTING FROM COLLISION TO PERMIT REPAIRS TO BE MADE BY REPAIRMAN CHOSEN BY INSURED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 193K, the following section: —

3 *Section 193L.* Every insurance policy written to cover physi-
4 cal damage to a motor vehicle resulting from a collision, shall
5 contain a provision allowing the insured to have his motor
6 vehicle repaired by a repairman of his own choice.

- 3 Section 1722. Every building erected within the limits of
- 4 the District of Columbia, or within the limits of any other
- 5 territory or possession of the United States, shall be
- 6 constructed in accordance with the provisions of this act.
