## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT PLACING ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE DIVISION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION INVESTIGATORS, FOOD AND DRUG INSPECTORS, CORRECTION AND TRANSPORTATION OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION, ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS APPOINTED BY THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES, PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING POLICE, UNDER THE CAREER INCENTIVE PAY PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws as most recently amended  
2 by chapter 835, section 108L of the acts of 1970 is further  
3 amended by adding in line 5 after the words, "metropolitan  
4 district commission police," the words, "and the enforcement  
5 officers in the division of law enforcement, department of  
6 natural resources, alcoholic beverages investigators, food and  
7 drug inspectors appointed under the authority of chapter 111,  
8 section 9, correction and transportation officers of the depart-  
9 ment of correction, enforcement officers of the registry of  
10 motor vehicles in the department of public works appointed by  
11 the registrar of motor vehicles under section 29 of chapter 90,  
12 public works building police."

13 Chapter 41 of section 108L is further amended by adding in  
14 line 33 after the words, "capitol police," the words, "enforce-  
15 ment officers in the division of law enforcement in the depart-  
16 ment of natural resources, alcoholic beverages investigators,

17 food and drug inspectors appointed under the authority of  
18 chapter 111, section 9, correction and transportation officers of  
19 the department of correction, enforcement officers of the regis-  
20 try of motor vehicles in the department of public works ap-  
21 pointed by the registrar of motor vehicles under section 29 of  
22 chapter 90, public works building police.”

23 Chapter 41, section 108L is further amended by adding in  
24 line 39 after the words, “capitol police,” the words, “by the  
25 commissioner of natural resources for the enforcement officers  
26 of the division of law enforcement, department of natural  
27 resources, chairman of the alcoholic beverages control com-  
28 mission, for the alcoholic beverages investigators, the com-  
29 missioner of public health for the food and drug inspectors, the  
30 commissioner of correction for the correction and transporta-  
31 tion officers, the registrar of motor vehicles for the registry of  
32 motor vehicles inspectors, the commissioner of public works  
33 for the public works police.
