AN ACT ESTABLISHING CERTAIN POSITIONS WITHIN THE STAFF OF  
THE PAROLE BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The fourth paragraph of section 4 of chapter 27 of the  
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of  
3 chapter 994 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by  
4 striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof  
5 the following sentence: —

6 The chairman shall be the executive and administrative head  
7 of said board, shall have the authority and responsibility of  
8 directing assignments of members of said board and shall be  
9 the appointing and removing authority for parole agents and  
10 other members of the parole staff which shall include an  
11 attorney who shall not be subject to the provisions of Chapter  
12 31 of the General Laws, an administrative assistant, an assistant  
13 to the chief supervisor, a parole training director, an executive  
14 secretary of the Advisory Board of Pardons and an adminis-  
15 trator for the executive secretary of the Advisory Board of  
16 Pardons.
