In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL REGISTERED VOTERS OVER THE AGE OF SIXTY-FIVE MAY VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 86 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "voter", in line 1, as
3 appearing in section 1 of chapter 213 of the acts of 1961, the
4 words: — age sixty-five or over or any voter.
