RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE SOURCES OF POLLUTION TO A CERTAIN BEACH IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

1 *Resolved*, That the Metropolitan District Commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and
3 study of the sources of pollution and methods in which they
4 can be abated relative to the Metropolitan District Beach in the
5 city of Quincy. Said commission shall report to the general
6 court the results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
7 mendations, if any, together with drafts of such legislation as
8 may be necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,
9 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representa-
10 tives on or before the last Wednesday of December, nineteen
11 hundred and seventy-one.
