AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF SURPLUS MONIES IN MUNICIPAL WATER DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

4 sentence the following sentence: — But in no event shall any
5 such net surplus be used for any purpose not connected with
6 the operation of the water department or water system.
