AN ACT REQUIRING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF A COUNTY TO SEND CERTAIN ESTIMATES TO THE MAYOR OF THE CITIES AND SELECTMEN OF THE TOWNS WHICH COMPRISE SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 28 of chapter 35 of the General Laws as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 70 of the acts of 1953, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following sentence: — The clerk of the  
5 county commissioners send a copy of the foregoing to the  
6 mayor of each city and the selectmen of each town which  
7 comprises the county at the same time copies are sent to the  
8 county treasurer and the director.
