AN ACT REVISING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE QUOTAS OF LICENSES IN CITIES AND TOWNS, EXCEPT THE CITY OF BOSTON, TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 453 of the acts of 1970, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the second paragraph
4 thereof, the following new paragraph: —

5 No limitation of the number of licenses herein provided shall
6 be applicable to a hotel of not less than one hundred
7 guest rooms, or to any restaurant containing all of the neces-
8 sary equipment and supplies for, and serving full course meals
9 regularly, and having accommodations for service for two hun-
10 dred or more patrons at tables, and occupying more than four
11 thousand square feet of space, provided, however, that any
12 licenses heretofore or hereafter issued to any such hotels or
13 restaurants shall not be moved to any new location, such
14 licenses being valid only on the premises of the hotel or
15 restaurant for which issued.
