AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSING OF DISTRICT COURTS ON SATURDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 1947, is hereby further amended by striking out the words
- 4 "other than district courts".
