AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF DAY CARE CENTERS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The department of community affairs is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to establish and maintain in cities and towns
- 3 throughout the commonwealth day care centers for pre-school
- 4 age children of working mothers whose family income, exclu-
- 5 sive of mother's earnings, is less than five thousand dollars.
- 6 Such centers shall be located in such cities and towns and
- 7 at such locations as shall be determined by the commissioners
- 8 of community affairs.
