## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**AN ACT EXEMPTING MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES FROM  
PAYING A MASSACHUSETTS STATE INCOME TAX.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Section 5B of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 557 of the acts of  
3 1969, is hereby further amended by adding the following  
4 paragraph: —

5 (7) An exemption equal to the monies received from the  
6 federal government for military service but excluding reserve  
7 service in the Massachusetts National Guard.
