AN ACT PROVIDING FOR RESIDENTIAL ZONING IN A COMMUNITY ADEQUATE IN RELATION TO ZONING FOR INDUSTRIAL USE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 40A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following: —
- 3 No change of any zoning ordinance or bylaw shall be
- 4 adopted pursuant to this section which has the effect of in-
- 5 creasing the land available for industrial use unless such change
- 6 also provides increased land available for residential use for
- 7 persons who would be employed by such industries.
