AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE RENDERING OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 7F, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter 219 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following: —

5 *Section 7F.* No person shall operate an ambulance or other
6 vehicle which is regularly used for the transportation of sick or
7 injured persons, or be an attendant thereon, unless such person
8 has successfully completed the standard or the advanced Red
9 Cross course of first aid training, or training and instruction
10 equivalent to such course, and shall be so certified by the Red
11 Cross or by a registered physician or licensed hospital, as the
12 case may be.
