AN ACT TO REMOVE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON TRUCKING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Amend section 13 of chapter 159B of the General Laws by
- 2 adding the following new paragraph: —
- 3 Motor Vehicles while engaged in the transportation of earth,
- 4 gravel, stone, bituminous materials used on construction within
- 5 the State shall be exempt from all provisions of this chapter
- 6 except sections three, four, nine and eighteen.
