AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN EXECUTIVE SECRETARY AND ASSISTANT FOR THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF NURSING HOME ADMINISTRATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 13, section 75 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting the
3 following new sentence: —

4 The board shall appoint an executive secretary, an assistant
5 executive secretary and such other employees as may be neces-
6 sary to carry out its duties and may expend therefor such sums
7 as may be appropriated.
