AN ACT CHANGING THE EMPLOYMENT STATUS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to
2 the contrary, all non-professional personnel serving under gov-
3 erning boards of institutions of higher education who are pre-
4 sently compensated under the O-3 Subsidiary Account shall
5 become state employees under the provisions of chapter 30 and
6 shall be employed in authorized permanent positions in accor-
7 dance with the provisions of section 45 of said chapter. Ir-
8 respective of the source of funds from which their salaries or
9 wages are paid, they shall have the same provisions and benefits
10 as all other employees of the Commonwealth such as retire-
11 ment benefits, group insurance, industrial accident coverage and
12 other coverage enjoyed by employees of the commonwealth.
