AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DIVISION OF CONTINUING STUDIES AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS AT SOUTHEASTERN MASSACHUSETTS UNIVERSITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be a program of continuing studies, including the
2 summer and evening schools, provided that the board of trust-
3 ees may expend from the receipts, without appropriation, in-
4 come derived from such courses as may be conducted at no net
5 expense to the Commonwealth, prior balances continued, and
6 provided, that any available public or private funds may also be
7 used in addition to the amounts made available for this pur-
8 pose, and further provided that such studies and programs be
9 furnished free of tuition charges to veterans on a space avail-
10 able basis, to be known as the Division of Continuing Studies
11 and Special Programs.
