RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF FEDERALLY FUNDED OR ASSISTED PROGRAMS CARRIED OUT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission consisting of two mem-  
2 bers of the senate, four members of the house of representa-  
3 tives and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study of the effect and impact of federal funds upon the  
6 operation of the state department of education and local muni-  
7 cipal school departments to determine whether such funds have  
8 interfered with or impeded the programs and policies estab-  
9 lished by the commonwealth or its political subsidiaries.
