By Mr. Young of Scituate, petition of John R. Healy, Jr., and George C. Young relative to the state contribution toward the federal project involving the dredging of certain areas in Scituate Harbor. Federal Financial Assistance.

## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH TO CONTRIBUTE A SUM OF MONEY TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TOWARD THE COST AND MAINTENANCE, IF REQUIRED, OF A CERTAIN PROJECT IN SCITUATE HARBOR.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized to pay  
2 to the Secretary of the Army, on his demand, the contribution  
3 required, if any, from local interests and to give to the said  
4 Secretary of the Army, the assurances required for this par-  
5 ticular project involving the dredging of certain areas in Scitu-  
6 ate Harbor to provide additional mooring facilities and further  
7 the said department is authorized to pay, as may be required  
8 by the said Secretary, from time to time, the additional costs  
9 necessary to maintain the areas so dredged; provided however  
10 that the town of Scituate has assumed liability only for dam-  
11 ages that may be incurred under said project in the manner  
12 provided by section 29 of chapter 91 of the General Laws.
